

Report of the  
**Internal Stakeholders Workshop held on 29-03-2019**

A round-table of internal stakeholders workshop was held at the e-Learning Centre Conference Hall in the afternoon of March 29, 2019. The meeting was attended by the faculty as well as the students.

On the date of the meeting, which was decided much earlier, a two-day University students cultural festival was announced and this had its impact on the attendance of both the faculty and students to the workshop. Faculty as well as the students who attended the workshop and they mentioned that it is an important workshop and were enthused by the prospects that the project could offer. They felt that it could be held at the level of Schools / Departments / Centres.

The participants were briefed about the INNOTAL project and also about the Talent Co-Creation Lab that we propose to initiate to encourage innovation and employability among the students, besides many other things that the project is aimed at. The participants were also given the handouts of the presentation and were requested to disseminate the same among the faculty colleagues and students.

Faculty members and students also felt the need for better co-ordination between and among the various cells in order to tap the potential of students in terms of their internships, innovation and placements.

Following the request of the participants, we have promised to reach out to larger sections of the University community in this regard and told the members that we can hold the workshops at the Schools level, if any representation comes from the schools.

The project team will soon initiate a discussion with the university administration to bring together various activities like incubation, innovation cell, placement and internships and projects all under one roof for better co-ordination and outcomes. The meeting will be held under the INNOTAL banner including heads of the various units mentioned above.

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
